Vanbrugh Hill - Safety and Pedestrian Improvements

As you may be aware there have been numerous incidents of vehicles using the wrong side of the road to overtake queuing traffic. This type of behaviour is incredibly dangerous and can result in serious injury especially to pedestrians. The Borough and the Metropolitan Police have discussed this issue and have decided to address this issue is to install traffic islands with keep left signs on them with the aim to enforce with cameras.

Proposed enforcement cameras will capture any vehicles travelling on the wrong side of the new island. This will result in fines being issued and potential prosecution to persistent offenders.

In addition, we have received petitions from residents regarding lack of crossing facilities on Vanbrugh Hill, this will also be addressed with the introduction of the traffic islands.

The construction of these islands will require parking spaces to be removed, new parking bays will be provided nearby on Vanbrugh Hill and Calvert Road.

The works are programmed to start 17th April 2023 and will take 3 weeks to complete, weather permitting. All works will be carried out Monday to Friday between 08:00 and 16:00.

Works will be done in two halves to maintain access for vehicles and pedestrians. Temporary traffic management will be in place during this time to minimise disruption to travel

Nature of these works will cause some noise and vibration, our contractors will be working to keep disruption to an absolute minimum, but the.
